Second Witness Statement of Alison Judith Oldfield

I, Alison Judith Oldfield of Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP ("Eversheds Sutherland") of Water Lane, Leeds LS11 5DR WILL SAY AS FOLLOWS:

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 I am a partner at Eversheds Sutherland and have conduct of this matter on behalf of each of the Claimants in the subject proceedings.
- 1.2 Unless I state otherwise, the facts in this statement are within my knowledge and true. Where the facts are not within my knowledge, they are true to the best of my knowledge and belief, and I identify the source of my knowledge.
- 1.3 References to page numbers in this statement are to page numbers in **Exhibit AJO2**.
- 1.4 This witness statement is made in respect of the subject proceedings, being:
 - 1.4.1 the proceedings with Claim Number QB-2022-001259 which relate to Shell Centre Tower, Belvedere Road, London ("the Shell Centre Tower Proceedings") in which Shell International Petroleum Company Limited ("SIPC") is the Claimant;
 - the proceedings with Claim Number QB-2022-001420 which relate to Shell petrol stations in England and Wales ("the Shell Petrol Stations Proceedings")
 in which Shell U.K. Oil Products Limited is the Claimant ("SUKOP"); and
 - 1.4.3 the proceedings with Claim Number QB-2022-001241 which relate to the oil refinery known as Shell Haven, Stanford Le-Hope the Manorway, Stanford Le-Hope ("the Shell Haven Proceedings") - in which Shell U.K. Limited is the Claimant ("Shell UK").
 - (SIPC, SUKOP and Shell UK together being "the Claimants" and the Shell Centre Tower Proceedings, the Shell Petrol Stations Proceedings and the Shell Haven Proceedings together being "the Proceedings").
- 1.5 In this statement I address the service of documents in respect of each of the Proceedings.

- A further email was sent at 15:00 to (a) confirm the totality of the documents served by email; and (b) advise that copies of the Shell Tower Centre Documents can also be viewed at https://shellservices.cmno.tech/. A copy of this email is exhibited at pages 18 19 of **Exhibit AJO2.**
- I should note that 46 automatic responses were received in response to the above emails. Having reviewed the timings of the automated responses, I believe that:
 - 2.5.1 30 of these automatic responses were received in respect of emails which relate to documents sent collectively in respect of the Shell Tower Proceedings, the Shell Haven Proceedings and the Shell Petrol Station Proceedings (being item numbers 1, 2, 3 and 5 in the above table) as the relevant email(s) sent contained attachments relevant to the Proceedings collectively. By way of illustration, (a) the email sent at 9:01 (exhibited at pages 1-2 of Exhibit AJO2) attached the sealed application and draft order in respect of each of the separate Proceedings and the email sent 10:52 and 11:07 (exhibited at pages 5-6 of Exhibit AJO2), attached the exhibits to my First Witness Statement (in two parts) such documents relate to each of the Proceedings. These 30 emails can be broken down into the following sub-categories:
 - 2.5.1.1 4 of the 30 emails were received from xr-international@protonmail.com which advised that the emails could not be delivered as the recipient's email address is possibly incorrect. A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 20 23 of Exhibit AJO2;

- 2.5.1.2 22 of the 30 emails appear to be automatic responses received from the following 6 email accounts: eoexrtnt@protonmail.com, xrmidlandstraining@protonmail.com, support@xrnorth.org, xrvideo@protonmail.com and xr-peoplesassembly@protonmail.com which advised that the emails could not be delivered as the relevant recipient's mailbox is full. A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 24 45 of Exhibit AJO2. I understand from this firm's IT team that these emails were properly sent but will not have been delivered to / received by the recipient mailbox as the mailboxes were full; and
- 2.5.1.3 4 of the 30 emails were received from press@extinctionrebellion.uk which appear to be automatic tailored responses to any emails received. These emails are titled "Thank you for contacting the Extinction Rebellion UK press team" and states that "This inbox is constantly monitored by our team and we will reply to urgent inquiries promptly". A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 45 49 of Exhibit AJO2.

Together, these 30 emails are defined as the "Wider Automated Responses".

- 2.5.2 in response to the emails issued which related to the Shell Centre Tower Proceedings only (being item number 4), and having reviewed the timings of the automated responses, I believe that a total of 12 of the 46 automatic responses were:
- 2.5.3 automatic responses received from the following 6 email accounts: eoexrtnt@protonmail.com, xrmidlandstraining@protonmail.com, xrdemocracy@protonmail.com, support@xrnorth.org, xrvideo@protonmail.com and xr-peoplesassembly@protonmail.com, These 12 automated responses advised that the emails could not be delivered as the relevant recipient's mailbox is full. A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 50 61 of Exhibit AJO2. I understand from this firm's IT team that these emails were properly sent but will not have been delivered to / received by the recipient mailbox as the mailboxes were full;
- 2.5.4 2 emails were received from <u>xr-international@protonmail.com</u> which advised that the emails could not be delivered as the recipient's email address is possibly incorrect. A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 62 63 of **Exhibit AJO2**; and
- 2.5.5 2 emails were received from press@extinctionrebellion.uk which appear to be automatic tailored responses to any emails received. These emails are titled

"Thank you for contacting the Extinction Rebellion UK press team" and states that "This inbox is constantly monitored by our team and we will reply to urgent inquiries promptly". A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 64 - 65 of **Exhibit AJO2**.

2.6 Further Email Responses Received on 10 April 2023

- 2.6.1 Further to issuing the Shell Tower Documents, the Shell Haven Documents and the Shell Petrol Station Documents by email as set out above and below (on 6 April 2023) a further 56 email responses were received on 10 April 2023 from 6 email accounts. As these automated responses were received after issuing the respective emails in respect of the Shell Tower Documents, the Shell Haven Documents and the Shell Petrol Station Documents by email it is not possible to reasonably conclude to which email these "bounce backs" are in respect of.
- 2.6.2 All 56 emails advised that an email could not be delivered as the recipient's mailbox is full. A copy of the relevant emails are exhibited at pages 66 121 of **Exhibit AJO2** but are also summarised in the below table.

- 2.6.3 I understand from this firm's IT team that these emails were properly sent but will not have been delivered to / received by the recipient mailbox as the mailboxes were full.
- 2.7 The automatic responses referred to at paragraphs 2.5.1.1 and 2.5.1.2, 2.5.3, 2.5.4 and 2.6.2 above, derive from 11 email addresses out of the total 49 email addresses linked to Extinction Rebellion, 1 email address out of the total 3 linked to Just Stop Oil and 1 email address out of the total 1 email addresses for Youth Climate Swarm, to which the abovementioned emails were sent.
- Apart from the automated response referred to above, no responses from any of the other 38 addresses linked to Extinction Rebellion were received. I have no reason to believe that the emails sent to the other 38 email addresses to which the abovementioned emails were sent were not delivered or received, and no 'bounce back' or delivery failure notifications in this regard were received. Similarly apart from the automated response referred to

above no responses from any of the other email addresses linked to Just Stop Oil were received.

- 2.9 I therefore consider that the remaining 38 emails sent to the email addresses linked to Extinction Rebellion and the remaining 2 emails sent to the email addresses linked to Just Stop Oil were sufficient for effecting service of the Shell Centre Tower Documents on these groups.
- 2.10 In respect of Youth Climate Swarm, this was the only email address provided for within the addresses listed in the 3 May 2022 Shell Centre Tower Order. I do not consider that there are further steps to be taken in respect of effecting service of the Shell Centre Tower Documents on this group as:
 - 2.10.1 this firm's IT team believes that these emails were properly sent but will not have been delivered to / received by the recipient mailbox as the mailboxes were full; and
 - 2.10.2 only 4 automatic responses were received in response to 16 emails sent to youthclimateswarm@protonmail.com in respect of the Shell Centre Tower Proceedings, I therefore have no reason to believe that the other 12 emails sent were not received bringing the proceedings and the hearing on 25 April to their attention.
- 2.11 For the reasons explained above, I believe that the steps taken in relation to service of documents upon the email addresses referred to at paragraphs 2.3 and 2.4 complied with the requirement upon SIPC to send emails to the addresses listed in the 3 May 2022 Shell Centre Tower Order.

Service by uploading to https://shellservices.cmno.tech

I am informed by Ms Pinkerton of the Claimants' previous solicitors (CMS Cameron McKenna Nabarro Olswang LLP ("CMS")) that a copy of the Shell Centre Tower Documents were uploaded to https://shellservices.cmno.tech on 6 April 2023, in compliance with paragraph 9(ii) of the 3 May 2022 Shell Centre Tower Order. A printout of the webpage at https://shellservices.cmno.tech showing that these documents continues to be uploaded to it is exhibited at page 122 of Exhibit AJO2.

- 2.14 In the circumstances I believe that service of the Shell Centre Tower Documents has been effected by the manner prescribed by the 3 May 2022 Shell Centre Tower Order. A Certificate of Service in relation to the Shell Centre Tower Documents has been filed. A copy of the Certificate is exhibited at pages 142 146 of **Exhibit AJO2**.
