### Ninth Witness Statement of Alison Judith Oldfield

I, Alison Judith Oldfield of Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP ("Eversheds Sutherland") of Water Lane, Leeds LS11 5DR WILL SAY AS FOLLOWS:

### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 I am a partner at Eversheds Sutherland and have conduct of this matter on behalf of each of the Claimants in the subject proceedings.

- 1.2 Unless I state otherwise, the facts in this statement are within my knowledge and true. Where the facts are not within my knowledge, they are true to the best of my knowledge and belief, and I identify the source of my knowledge.
- 1.3 References to page numbers in this statement are to page numbers in **Exhibit AJO9**.
- 1.4 The purpose of this witness statement is to confirm the steps taken to serve the various parties to these proceedings with documents in preparation for the renewal hearing on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> April 2024. In particular:
  - 1.4.1 my eighth witness statement which confirms the steps taken to serve the evidence in support of the Claimants' renewal application and amended pleadings in the Petrol Stations proceedings;
  - 1.4.2 the Claimants' applications for a variation of the provisions ordered in each of these proceedings relating to alternative service together with draft orders;
  - 1.4.3 the notice of hearing relating to the renewal hearing
  - 1.4.4 the hearing bundle
  - 1.4.5 a supplemental bundle
- 1.5 To the extent necessary, the court's confirmation is also sought that those steps amount to good service.

# 2. Service upon the Named Defendants in the Petrol Station Proceedings ("the Named Defendants")

- 2.1 Paragraph 7 of the Order of Soole J dated 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 ("the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 Order") provides that the Named Defendants in the Petrol Station proceedings should be served:
  - 2.1.1 by uploading it to <u>http://www.noticespublic.com</u>;
  - 2.1.2 by posting to their last known address which was supplied to the Claimant in the Petrol Station proceedings by the relevant police authority by first class post, special delivery and/or by hand delivery; unless any defendant has also confirmed they will accept service by email pursuant to CPR Rule 6A paragraph 4.1.
  - 2.1.3 In addition, (and to the extent possible) the Third (Harris) and Tenth (Burns) defendants may also be served by social media.
- 2.2 Paragraph 8 of the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 Order permits service of documents upon the Fifteenth Defendant (Holland) by the same means provided for in respect of the First Defendant (Persons Unknown).

Service of the Notice of Hearing, Application Notice and Draft Order relating to variation of service provisions and the Eighth Witness Statement of Alison Oldfield on the Named Defendants.

- 2.3 The following documents were served upon the Named Defendants in relation to the Claimants' application for the renewal of the injunction in the Petrol Station proceedings:
  - 2.3.1 Notice of hearing for the review hearing to take place on 17 April 2024;
  - 2.3.2 The unsealed Application Notice relating to variation of the service provisions and draft orders (in the Petrol Station proceedings);
  - 2.3.3 The Eighth Witness Statement of Alison Oldfield dated 11 April 2024 and exhibit;
- 2.4 I shall refer to all these documents collectively as the "**Petrol Stations Service Variation** and Notice of Hearing Documents".
- 2.5 Copies of the Petrol Stations Service Variation and Notice of Hearing Documents were served by hand on all the Named Defendants except for Emma Ireland and Philip Laurie by delivering by hand using a process server, Finlays Legal Limited ("Finlays") in accordance with paragraph 7.3 of the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 Order. As I explained at paragraph 2.3 of my eighth witness statement, both Messrs Laurie and Ireland have confirmed they consent to being served with documents in the proceedings by email. I will return to the process of serving on those defendants below.
- 2.6 There is now produced and shown to me marked **AJO9 pages 1-16** copies of a series of statements of service prepared by the individuals at Finlays Legal Limited who were responsible for service of the Petrol Station Service Variation and Notice of Hearing Documents. The information I have set out in this witness statement is obtained from those statements and I believe it to be true. In summary, those statements confirm that the relevant process server delivered parcels containing the documents listed at paragraph 2.3 to the Named Defendants as follows:
  - 2.6.1 On 11<sup>th</sup> April 2024 to the last known addresses for Micheal Davies and Tessa-Marie (Tez) Burns;
  - 2.6.2 On 12<sup>th</sup> April 2024 to the last known addresses for Louis McKechnie, Louise Harris, Callum Goode, Christopher Ford, Sean Jordan, Michael Davies, Kate Bramfit, Simon Reding, David Nixon and Margaret Reid.
- 2.7 At **page 17 of AJO9** I have exhibited an example of the covering letter which accompanied the Petrol Stations Service Variation and Notice of Hearing Documents in the case of each Named Defendant. The exact time of delivery in respect of each Named Defendant is recorded in the statements of service at **pages 1-16 of AJO9**.
- 2.8 We also sent a copy of the Petrol Stations Service Variation and Notice of Hearing Documents to Charles Philip Laurie and Emma Ireland by emails both sent at 17:46pm on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2024. The emails were sent by my colleague, Alexander Wright from this firm's

centralised Shell Service email account – ShellService@eversheds-sutherland.com. Copies of the emails to Mr Laurie and Ms Ireland are at **pages 18-21.1 of AJO9.** 

- 2.9 In addition a message was also sent on 11 April 2024 via direct message to the Facebook page of Louise Harris advising her that should could find copies of the Petrol Stations Service Variation and Notice of Hearing Documents via the <u>www.noticespublic.com</u> data site. A copy of this message can be found at **pages 22-23of AJO9.**
- 2.10 It has not been possible to upload a similar message to the LinkedIn account of Tessa-Marie (Tez) Burns (as we originally envisaged) because Ms Burns has still not responded to our initial message of 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Screenshots of the error message we received when attempting to serve Ms Burns on 11 April 2024 can be found at **page 24-25 of AJO9.**

Service of the Sealed Application Notice, Claimant's Skeleton Argument, Draft Order seeking continuation of the injunction and directions and summary table of witness evidence in the Proceedings the Named Defendants.

- 2.11 The following documents were also served upon the Named Defendants in relation to the Claimants' application for the renewal of the injunction in each proceedings:
  - 2.11.1 Sealed Application Notice dated 11 April 2024 for the variation of service provisions in respect of the Petrol Stations Proceedings;
  - 2.11.2 Claimant's Skeleton Argument;
  - 2.11.3 Draft Order seeking continuation of the injunction and directions in respect of the Petrol Stations Proceedings; and
  - 2.11.4 Summary table of witness evidence in the proceedings.
- 2.12 I shall refer to all these documents collectively as the **"Sealed Application and Submissions for the Petrol Stations Proceedings**".
- 2.13 Copies of the Sealed Application and Submissions for the Petrol Stations Proceedings were served by hand on all the Named Defendants except for Emma Ireland and Philip Laurie by delivering by hand using Finlays (defined above) in accordance with paragraph 7.3 of the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 Order.
- 2.14 There is now produced and shown to me marked **AJO9 pages 26-41** copies of an additional series of statements of service prepared by the individuals at Finlays Legal Limited who were responsible for service of the Sealed Application and Submissions for the Petrol Stations Proceedings. The information I have set out in this witness statement is obtained from those statements and I believe it to be true. In summary, those statements confirm that the relevant process server delivered parcels containing the documents listed at paragraph 2.11 to the Named Defendants as follows:
  - 2.14.1 On 15<sup>th</sup> April 2024 to the last known address for David Nixon.

- 2.19 It has not been possible to upload a similar message to the LinkedIn account of Tessa-Marie (also known as Tez) Burns (as we originally envisaged) because Ms Burns has still not responded to our initial message of 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024 and it has not therefore been possible to communicate further via this means with Ms Burns. Screenshots of the error message we received when attempting to serve Ms Burns on 15 April 2024 can be found at **pages 24-25 of AJO9.**

Service of the Hearing Bundle and the Supplemental Bundle for the hearing on 17th April 2024 on the Named Defendants.

- 2.20 The Order dated 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 requires the hearing bundles to be served by electronic means only. Service of the hearing and supplemental bundles has therefore only been effected on those Named Defendants who have consented to service by email.
