UPON the Second Defendant (Mr Andrew Daniel Smith) undertaking to the Court that he will not do any of the following activities prohibited by the Order of Mr Justice Bennathan dated 28 April 2022 for a period of one calendar year from the date of that Order or further orders (in which case this undertaking will be extended on the same terms and for the same duration as any further order), or until trial whichever is sooner:

- (a) Enter or remain upon any part of Shell Centre Tower without the consent of the Claimant;
- (b) Block access to any of the doors which provide access and egress to and from the Shell Centre Tower;
- (c) Cause damage to any part of Shell Centre Tower whether by:
 - (i) Affixing themselves, or any object, or thing, to any part of the Shell Centre Tower, or to any other person or object or thing on or in Shell Centre Tower:

- (ii) Erecting any structure in, on or against Shell Centre Tower;
- (iii) Spraying, painting, pouring, sticking or writing with any substance on or inside any part of Shell Centre Tower; or
- (iv) Otherwise;

AND UPON the Claimant agreeing to withdraw its claim against the Second Defendant on that basis.

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The Second Defendant (Mr Andrew Daniel Smith) be removed as a party to the Claim;
- 2. Each party shall bear its own costs of and associated with this Order.
- 3. Service is dispensed with and the Claimant will arrange for a copy of the Order to be made available via the Shell Services Website (https://shellservices.cmno.tech).
